Florida State's swimming team coasted to its second straight victory, defeating Georgia Tech 74-21 here last night.

Tech's Larry Caghan won the only first place for the Yellow Jackets, edging FSU's Richard Abbott in the 100 - yard freestyle and breaking a meet record in the process.

Seminole sophomore Mike Blouin defeated the Tech ace by a slim margin in the 50yard freestyle, setting another meet record with a time of 0:22.9 seconds.

Biggest surprise of the evening was Larry Profumo's performance in the springboard diving event. The Louisville, Ky. soph gave teammate Neal Allen his first defeat in intercollegiate diving. Allen was undefeated in ten straight dual meets up until last night.
