

CHAPEL HILL, N.C.—Florida State's swimmers, competing away from home for the first time this season, decisively defeated North Carolina in a 60-35 dual meet Friday.

Winning was a double pleasure for Coach Bim Stults' Floridians. The Tar Heels were one of two teams to top the Seminoles last season. Florida State stands 4-0 now.

It was the second setback for North Carolina in as many days. The Tar Heels, 7-2 overall, were nipped by Florida 48-47 Thursday.

The FSU 400-yard medley relay team, composed of Jim Mullally, Doug Kruger, John Rangely and Richard Abbott, was tops with a time of 3:43.5, a school record.

Sophomore Jim Mauldin, a Mississippi boy, bagged a first in the 200-yard freestyle. He swam it in 1:52.4, a school mark.

The Seminoles swim against East Carolina at Greenville today. Next Tallahassee meet is Monday against Tulane.

Standout sophomores again sparked FSU in yesterday's meet. The Seminoles snared first places in seven of 11 events, and sophomores were first in four of the seven.

Abbott, a sophomore from Lyndon, Ky., finished first in the 200-yard individual medley, swimming it in 2:13.

Another second-year man, Mike Blouin, captured honors in the 50-yard freestyle. The Charleston, S. C., native did it in 22.7.

A brilliant diving exhibition by FSU's Larry Profumo earned him a first place. The Louisville, Ky., sophomore was fol-

lowed by another Seminole, junior Neil Allen.

Letterman Gene Dayton turned in a 5:26 in the 500-yard freestyle for another FSU first. Another junior, Sherm Henderson, was first in the 200-yard breaststroke, posting a 2:26.

Events captured by the Tar Heels were the 200-yard butterfly, the 100-yard freestyle, the 200-yard backstroke and the 400 yard freestyle relay.

Seminole coach Stults had called North Carolina "one of the best teams in the South" before yesterday's meet, and last night had high praise for his tankers "for a job terrifically well done."
