GREENVILLE, N. C. — Winning six of 11 events, Florida State's swimmers splashed past tough East Carolina College in a 55-40 dual match Saturday afternoon.

The victory improved Florida State's record to 5-0. East Carolina stands 3-3.

It was the second straight defeat at the hands of a Florida team for East Carolina. University of Florida tankers beat the Pirates 53-42 Friday.

Florida State's swimmers return to Tallahassee for a meet with Tulane tomorrow night at 8 in Montgomery Gymnasium.

Yesterday's meet was a close one all the way, with the under-

dog Pirates leading much of the distance.

The Seminoles captured top place in the first two events, the 400-yard medley relay and the 200-yard freestyle.

The FSU medley relay team, composed of Jim Mullally, Doug Kruger, Richard Abbott and Alan Roles, posted a time of 3:49.6.

Top man in the 200-yard freestyle was sophomore Jim Mauldin, who swam it in 1:55.6.

East Carolina captured the next two events, with times of 22.7 in the 50-yard freestyle and 2:11.5 in the 200-yard individual medley.

FSU junior Neil Allen placed first in diving competition, followed by another Seminole, sophomore Larry Profumo.

The Pirates then won two straight events — the 100-yard freestyle, with a :50.0, and the 200-yard backstroke, on a time of 2:09.0 for a school record.

FSU's Gene Dayton then churned out a 5:27.9 in the 500-

yard freestyle for a first place. Seminole Richard Greene won the next event, registering a 2:24.2 in the 200-yard breaststroke.

The Carolina swimmers won the final event, with a 3:29.4 in the 400-yard freestyle relay.
