

ATHENS, Ga. — Living up to their pre-meet designation as the South's best, Florida State's swimming Seminoles mounted a substantial lead after the first day of competition ended in the Southeastern Intercollegiate Championships Friday.

Coach Bim Stults' Seminoles compiled 73 points in Friday action. University of Florida tankers, defending meet champions, were a distant second with 46.

Other teams and their scores: Florida frosh, 23; Georgia Tech, 14; FSU frosh, 13; Miami, 9; Georgia, 7; Dade Junior College, 5; Georgia frosh, 1.

FSU captured first place in only two events, but finished strong in the remaining five places to reap most of its points.

Seminole Doug Kruger finished first in the 200-yard breaststroke, a meet and school record with a time of 1:50.0. The FSU 400-yard medley relay team established another meet record enroute to its first-place time of 3:43.4. That team was composed of Dick Acosta, Kruger, John Rangely and Dick Abbott.

Competition ends today in the two-day championships sponsored by the University of Georgia.

ATHENS, Ga. — Florida set four new individual meet records here Saturday, but favored Florida State piled up the points when needed to capture the Southeastern Intercollegiate swimming championships.

The final tally was FSU 136, Florida 107, Florida Freshmen 41, Miami 24, FSU Freshmen 20, Georgia Tech 19, Georgia 15, Dade Junior College 15

(tie), and Georgia Freshmen 1.

The FSU team of Dale Smith, Allan Rolles, Charlie Robertson, John Rangeley, Jim Mauldin and Mike Blouin won the 400-yard freestyle relay and set a new meet record of 3:21.4 in the process.

The Seminoles led with 73 points Friday at the end of the first day's competition in the weekend event sponsored by the University of Georgia.

Florida, the defending champion here, had only 46 points Friday, but staged a strong comeback during the meet's windup.

Miami's Jim Fitzgibbons established a new mark of 48.7 in the 100-yard freestyle.

Other new records, all by Florida swimmers, were Dick Farwell, 57.2; 100-yard backstroke; Sandy Chandler, 1:03.6, 100-yard breaststroke; Jerry Livingston, 52.5, 100-yard butterfly; and Ray Whitehouse, 2:04.7, 200-yard individual medley.
