Florida State coasted to its, e fourth straight swimming vici tory here yesterday afternoon at the expense of a game but - outmanned Alabama team. The final score was 69-26, and the Seminoles pulled their punches from the start. The Crimson Tide brought only seven swimmers and two I divers for the meet against the t undefeated Seminoles of Bim [Stults The class of the lot was freestyler Tom Allen, a junior col--liege All-American from Encino, Calif. who won the 200 and 500yard freestyle to become the meet's only dual winner. Allen set two meet records and his time of 1:55.8 in the 200 is a record for FSU's new union pool. Florida State won seven of the 11 events, including Neal Allen's third straight diving victory. Allen and sophomore Bob Cruickshank finished one - two over Alabama's highly - regarded Larry Everingham. FSU's Larry Profumo did not compete.

Aithough most of Florida State's top swimmers saw only exhibition duty, one sophomore, looked more and more like a comer for the Seminoles. Tom Lloyd won the 50-yard freestyle in creditable 0:23.3 time over Bama's Doug Long. Other winners for Florida State-were-Tut Heisler in the 200-yard individual medley, Bob Durocher in the 200-yard butterfly, Jim Mullally in the 200yard backstroke, and Jack Barncastle in the 200 - yard breaststroke. The Seminoles took both relay events. Stults' tankers take on two of the best teams in the south here Friday and Saturday, meeting North Carolina and N. C. State: both Atlantic Coast Conference Dowers. ^{5,7}These two, along with Florida, constitute the major threat in the Seminoles' bid to repeat their undefeated record of last vear.
