

**Florida State's powerful-swimming team left Florida foundering in its wake here Saturday afternoon as the Seminoles swept to a 72-23 victory—their 15th straight over a two-year period.**

Florida was able to win only two events as FSU Coach "Bim" Stults pulled out all the stops, swimming his top men in virtually every race. It practically cinched a second straight undefeated season for the Seminole tankers, who have only a Tuesday meet with East Carolina College left on the schedule.

One of the highlights of the meet came in the third event when FSU junior Charles Robertson, a sleeper this season, nosed out Florida's brilliant sophomore Tom Dioguardi in the 50-yard freestyle.

It was Dioguardi's first defeat of his college career, however, he came on to beat out FSU's Dick Abbott and Robertson in the 100-yard freestyle. Florida's only other first place was an easy victory by Blanchard Tual in the 200-yard backstroke.

In the first event of the afternoon, Abbott, with a slight lead built by Jack Jaisler, Doug Kruger and Jim Mauldin, held off Dioguardi to give the Seminoles a seven-point win in the 400-medley relay.

Sophomore Tom Lloyd and Mike Blouin swept home in the 200-yard freestyle, then came Robertson's upset in the 50.

Easily FSU's strongest and most versatile swimmer, Abbott was an easy winner in the 200-yard individual medley over Florida's Charlie King. The three-meter diving was no contest with Neal Allen and Bob Cruickshank finishing one - two for the Seminoles.

Bob Durocher had never won a first place for Florida State, but the Ozone Park, N.Y. senior came home ahead of teammate Don Hartke to give FSU another one-two finish in the 200-yard butterfly.

Dioguardi and Tual won their events back to back, but FSU captured second and third in each to put the meet out of reach.

Gene Dayton and Blouin staged a duel to the wire in the 500-yard freestyle with Dayton the winner by an arm's length, and Florida's third-place finisher a pool length behind.

Soph Mike Koch won the 200-yard breaststroke and the freestyle relay team coasted home in meet record time.

Times were not outstanding. Only three meet records fell, and Tual's backstroke victory was the only pool record set.

Florida State's freshmen set the pace for their teammates in a meet immediately preceeding the varsity event, defeating the Gator frosh, 63-34.

Seeley Feldmeyer was a double-winner for the FSU frosh, setting freshman records in both the 100 and 200-yard freestyle events. Terry Schlichenmaier set a yearling mark in the 100-backstroke.
