Despite an 82-23 shellacking of Georgia Tech last Friday, Florida State swimming coach Blm-Stults is anything but optimistic about his club's chances against a powerful Florida team this Saturday at Gainesville.

"About the only thing we learned at the Georgia Tech meet was that we are not

as ready as I hoped we would be at this time," said the 18-year veteran of the Seminoles' swimming wars.

"I know less about this group of swimmers than any I have ever had," Stults added. He emphasized his point by noting he has scheduled time trials this afternoon to determine which swimmers would make the Gainesville trip.

The Gators have one of their strongest teams ever, "if not the strongest," Stults noted.

Florida has added a group of talented sophomores to go with veterans Tom Dioguardi and Blanchard Tual for a strong, well-balanced attack.

Seminole assistant coach Bill Faunce scouted the Gators last week in a meet against Georgia, and came back impressed.

Florida is weakest at the breaststroke and in the diving competition, and the Seminoles will have to show strong there to challenge.

Faunce noted, however, that he felt the two relays would be the meet's telling events.

The Seminoles did not take their best swimmers to Georgia Tech. Stults was hoping to give the younger boys, who will be relied on for depth, a chance to get some experience.

Despite the lopsided score Stults was disappointed with his team's showing on the clocks.

"Out times just weren't what they should have been at this point. Our boys haven't had a chance to show if they are ready or not. If enough of them are ready, we will give Florida a real good meet," he said.

While Stults is worried about his varsity swimmers, the freshmen, who work under the tutelage of last year's varsity captain Dick Abbott, drew praise. "They performed real well," the head coach said.

He noted the yearlings set two school and a pool record en route to a double-dual meet win over the Georgia Tech frosh (82-23) and Marist High School of Atlanta (62-42).

The freshmen take on the Gator frosh at 1:30 Saturday prior to the varsity meet.
