North Carolina State, one of the South's best swimming teams, handed Florida State its first setback of the season yesterday at Union Pool, gaining a 55-49 decision.

Fourteen records fell in the chilly weather, including eight pool marks.

The Wolf Pack, now 8-1, for the year with their only loss being to national power Yale, captured seven first places to five for the Seminoles, who own a 3-1 record.

North Carolina State's outstanding freestyler, Steve

Rerych, was the one double winner. The Patterson, N.J., junior won the 50 and 100-yard freestyles and on both

occasions he set pool records.

On the Florida State side of the ledger, Barry Rich, the Seminoles' fine sophomore, turned in a great effort in the 200-yard butterfly. The Birmingham, Ala., product raced to a 1:59.4 performance to better the pool, meet, and Seminole varsity record.

This was the Seminoles' first defeat in double competition at Union Pool since Florida State moved there for the 1964 season.

Diving was the only event in which Florida State could place one, two against the Wolfpack, which defeated the University of Florida in Gainesville Friday, 60 - 44. Florida's All-American Tom Dioguardi beat Rerych, the national champ, in the 100-yard free.

Seminoles Carl Springfels and Bob Cruickshank swept the diving event.

The Florida State four hundred yard relay team

turned in a record performance with a new pool mark of 3:16.4 The team was composed of Tommy Lloyd, Bob Bell, Hod Gray and Seeley Feldmeyer.

Feldmeyer, an Annapolis, Md., junior lowered the meet record in the 200-yard freestyle with a 1:47.4 clocking.

The other Seminole victory went to Ed Helquist in the 200-yard breaststroke with a time of 2:23.6.
