The University of Florida swimming team, led by All-America and team captain Tom Dioguardi earned a narrow 54-50 win over Florida State yesterday in a meet which was not decided until the final stroke of the last event.

Dioguardi, with two wins to his credit already in the cold afternoon's competition, took off a second after the

Seminole's Jim Thompson on the final leg of the 400-yard freestyle relay and caught the Tribe anchor man three strokes from the end for a six-inch victory.

It was the Gators' first win in eight tries over the last four years over FSU.

In all, four meet and three pool records fell in the contest with all but one of them going to the fired-up Gators.

Florida's medley relay team of Blanchard Tual, Joe Scafuti, Tom Macri and Andy McPherson got the Gators off on the right foot, with a meet and pool record effort of 3:40.1 in that event.

The Florida State team, which had beaten the Gators in the medley in Gainesville last month, was disqualified when one member made an early start.

The Gators' winning freestyle relay cracked two more records with a 3:14.4 showing in the meet-winning event.

Florida's Barry Russo picked up the final pair of records that went to the reptiles as he avenged his earlier loss to the Seminole Barry Rich with a

1:57.6 clocking in the 200 yard butterfly.

Steven McNerney picked the Seminole record in the 500-yard freestyle with a 5:10.5 mark. He eclipsed the old meet record by five seconds.

McNerney was the Tribe's strongest performer with wins in the 500 and the 1000-yard freestyle events.

In a surprise move, Tribe coach Bim Stults entered sprint freestyler Seeley Feldmeyer in the 200-yard Individual Medley, and the big Seminole junior finished a close second to Florida's Andy McPherson.

The move backfired, however, when Feldmeyer, apparently tired by his IM effort finished a distant fourth in his usually strong 100-yard free style event.

Dioguardi's two wins came in the 50 and 100-yard freestyle events, which are his specialty.

Florida State's freshman team removed some of the sting from the varsity loss with a solid 77-18 whipping of the Baby Gators.

The Florida Frosh were never in the meet, as all Dick Abbott's Tribe freshman would allow them were a first place in the 50-yard freestyle and two second places.

The Seminole varsity will attempt to get back into the win column Tuesday when East Carolina College comes to Tallahassee for a 3 p.m. contest.

The Tribe's record is now 5-2 while the Gators are 8-3.
