MIAMI — Florida State's varsity and freshman swimming teams swept to victory Friday, the varsity downing the University of Miami 57-47 and the freshmen clipping Miami-Dade Junior College 50-35.

The Seminoles will meet the swimmers from the University of South Florida this afternoon in Tampa.

The new University of Miami Union Pool was the scene of the clash and seven pool records and two Miami varsity marks were turned in.

Miami set five records, while the Seminoles were able to knock off three.

Diving once again proved to again be one of Florida State's strongest events as the Seminoles took it one, two. Randy Stewart was first while Carl Springfels followed.

The only swimming event in which the Seminoles were able to cop the first two places was the 100-yard freestyle in which Bob Bell took first and Tom Lloyd was second.

Florida State took only two other individual first places in the meet. Dave Gibson set a new pool record in the 50-yard freestyle and Barry Rich took a first, setting a pool record in the 200-yard butterfly.

Gibson's time was 22.6, Rich's 2:02.1.

Florida State wrapped up the meet taking the 400-yard freestyle relay with a new pool record of 3:20.5. Members of the Seminole relay team were Tom Lloyd, Hud Gray, Bob Bell and Ken Palmer.

The victory gives the Seminoles a 6-2 record, while the University of Miami is 5-3.

In the freshman meet, the Baby Seminoles had no trouble

whatsoever splashing pass the Miami - Dade Junior College squad.

The Frosh team had seven of the 11 first place positions in the competition.
