TAMPA — Florida State's swim team lost both relay matches Saturday, but swept to first-second place finishes in five events and captured a 56-45 verdict over the University of South Florida.

The FSU freshmen, unbeaten in five outings, also were victorious, registering a 52-41 decision over Jesuit High of Tampa.

The varsity took the top two spots in the 1,000-yard freestyle, 200-yard individual medley, one-meter diving, and 200-yard breaststroke to make up for the loss suffered in the relays.

Only double winner for Florida State was Jim Thompson who turned the feat in the 1,000-yard and 500-yard freestyles.

Other firsts for the Seminoles were by Tom Lloyd (200-yard freestyle), Dave Gibson (50-yard freestyle), Gary Trimble (200-yard individual medley), Carl Springfels (diving), K. C. Dawson (200-yard butterfly) and Jeff Heatley (200-yard breaststroke).

Florida State also had six second place finishes and a third place.

The triumph boosted the Seminoles' record to 7-2. The varsity defeated the University of Miami Friday.

The freshmen took first-place finishes in seven of the eleven events to outpoint Jesuit.

Winning events for the Baby Seminoles were Jim Harris (200-yard freestyle), Chip Jones (50-yard freestyle), Denny Shiels (200-yard individual medley), Dan Richardson (100-yard butterfly), Bill Pocock, Brendle, Bruce Rathman and Al Dorian also combined to take the 200-yard medley relay for FSU.

The varsity takes a break this week with no action slated. Next meet for the Seminoles is a week from Saturday when Miami visits Tallahassee.
