Florida State's swimming team closed out its dual meet season on a winning note Saturday, breezing to a 65-39 win over Miami.

The Tribe swept seven first places enroute to its ninth victory against two setbacks.

Steve McNerney led the Seminole charge with a varsity record time of 10:48.4 in the 1000-yard freestyle. He eclipsed his own mark of 10:50.7 by better than two seconds.

Junior freestyler Bob Bell, who usually is relied on for work in the relay events, was given a shot at the 50 and 100-yard freestyle sprints, and responded with a double win.

Bell was given his chance when regular sprinter Seeley Feldmeyer was sidelined with the flu.

Miami's Russ Tongay and Mike Szydlo turned in double wins in a losing cause for the Hurricanes.

Tongay won the 200 and 500-

yard freestyle events, while Szydlo turned in wins in the individual medley and the breaststroke.

Other first place finishers for FSU were Randy Stewart (diving), Barry Rich (200-yard butterfly), the 400-yard medley relay team of Hod Gray, Jeff Heatley, Rich and Tom Lloyd and the 400-yard

freestyle relay foursome of Lloyd, Bob Aldrich, Terry Schlickemaier and Chuck Busse.

Jim Thompson logged two second places for the Seminoles in the 200 and the 500-yard freestyles. Miami's Don Mitchell was second in the 1000 and 100-yard freestyles.
