Florida State's swimming team defeated an outmanned but game Tulane Green Wave 60-51 at the Union Pool yesterday.

Three meet and one Tulane school record fell during the day's competition as Seminole Coach Bim Stults used mostly freshman swimmers against the visitors.

Meet records in the two diving events were set by Florida State performers, while Tulane's John Rouquette bettered the meet and Green Wave mark in the 200-yard breaststroke with a 2:22.5 clocking.

Seminoles Phil Boggs and Terry Maxhimer set records in

the three and one-meter diving events with 289.9 and 217.4 points respectively.

Florida State broke out to a 15-1 lead, winning the opening medley-relay, and sweeping the 1000-yard freestyle, but the Green Wave rolled back, and closed the gap to 40-37 with just four events remaining.

The Tribe came surging back, however, sweeping the next two events to put the meet out of reach.
