CHAPEL HILL — Florida State swimmers suffered their second setback of the weekend to a North Carolina school as the University of North Carolina dunked the Seminoles 59-54 Saturday.

Florida State captured only five firsts while the Tar Heels got eight.

One of the most surprising turns in the meet, was the failure of the Seminoles to finish 1-2 in diving competition. FSU's Denny Shields took the one-meter event, but for the first time this year, the Seminoles didn't win the three-meter event as North

Carolina's Jim Carney nabbed first place ahead of FSU's Randy Stewart.

A judges' decision in the 200-yard freestyle gave Florida State's Seeley Feldmeyer a victory over the Tar Heel's Tom Edwards.

The Seminoles' tankmen set two new school records in the 1000-yard freestyle and 50-yard freestyle. Steve McNerny snapped six seconds off his old mark in 1000-yard event with a time of 10:40.7. Dave Gibson set the new mark in the 50-yard event with a time of 22.1. The old record was held by teammate Feldmeyer.
