Saturday's chill wind did little to cool off the red-hot Florida State swimmers as the Seminoles raced to their second win in as many days, dowing the University of South Florida 72-40 at Union Pool;

The Tribe captured all but three of 13 events including sweeps in four events.

Three meet, one varsity and 2
Union Pool records fell during
the brisk afternoon's competition. Diver Howie Acosta
set the varsity-pool-mark with
an award of 296.8 points in the
three-meter event. Other meet
records fell to Seminole Jim
Thompson in the 100-yard
freestyle when the big senior
finished in 10:51.3 and to the

Tribe 400-yard freestyle relay team of Wayne Morse, Lee, Eisinger, Jim Stevens and Howard Gray clocked in a 3:25.9.

"We are happy with the outcome of these two meets." said Seminole Coach Bim Stults whose charges downed. Evansville 62-49 Friday. "But we certainly needed the experience. A lot of our boys looked ragged out there.

"We are about where we thought we would be for thistime of the year, but there is still a long way to go before we get into the meat of our schedule."

The Seminoles opened against South Florida with a win in the medley relay, and then proceeded to sweep the first two places in each of the next three events for an almost insurmountable 31-3 lead.

South Florida did not gain a first place until the seventh event, the 200-yard butterfly, where it took first and second. The Brahmans took the next two events, the 100-yard

freestyle and the backstroke for their only wins.

The Seminoles will send a contingent to the two-week long. Aquatic Forum in Ft. Lauderdale next week. Florida State's next duel meet will be Jan. 9 against Georgia here.
