Florida State's swim team held a tar and feather party at the Union Pool Friday afternoon as the Seminoles breezed to a surprisingly easy 70-43 win over North Carolina.

Things could be a little stickier for Coach Bim Stults' swimmers this afternoon, however, as N.C. State, a club the Tribe hasn't beaten in three years, moves in for a 2 p.m. meet.

The Seminoles were never in serious trouble Friday as they limited the Atlantic Coast Conference co-favorites to five points in the first six events.

The medley relay team of Dennis Shiels, Norm Loges, Bruce Rathman and Jim Harrison started things off right with a meet record clocking of 3:40.1. The time also tied the existing pool mark.

The first five individual events found the Seminoles capturing both first and second places, limiting the Tar Heels

The Tribe captured eight of the 13 events and placed second in ten, as Stults used all but one of his swimmers.

Dean Jerger tied a meet record in the 50-yd. freestyle for the Seminoles with a 22.1 clocking.

The only one other mark to fall went to diver Phil Boggs, who garnered an award of 278.35 in the one-meter competition. It was a new meet, pool and FSU record, and he now holds both the one and three meter records.
