North Carolina State which lost its first meet in four years to Florida, Friday, slipped by Florida State 63-50 Saturday afternoon at Union Pool.

The meet, one of the fastest ever held at FSU, saw eight meet records and seven pool standards eclipsed.

The Wolfpack set five of the meet marks and four pool, while winning nine of the 13 events.

The Seminoles set three pool, school and meet standards in their four wins.

Florida State's top backstroker and Individual Medley man, Dennis Shields, did not perform, costing the Tribe points in those two events and the Medley Relay. The junior team captain reported a 102-degree fever Saturday morning and was confined to the University Infirmary.

Despite his loss, however, the Seminoles brought the meet down to the final event, the 400-yard freestyle relay. N.C. State prevailed by three-tenths of a second in a record breaking 3:12.7 time.

Phil Boggs, the Seminoles' premier diver, led the Tribe to sweeps of the one and three meter board events.

He collected record totals of 334.1 (three-meter) and 308.3 (one-meter).

N.C. State's Steve McGrain picked up wins in the 1000 and 500 yard freestyle events with across the board record clockings of 10:22.0 and 4:58.1 respectively.

Freshman Norm Loges pulled up with a big clutch win for the Seminoles in the 200-yard breaststroke when he clocked in a record 2:17.9. Anything less than a first place finish would have eliminated the Tribe from the competition, but he came through and won by a length.

Florida State's record is now 4-2, while N.C. State is 6-1. The Seminoles swim again Tuesday, when South Carolina moves into Union Pool.

The Gamecocks were third in the Atlantic Coast Conference last season, to North Carolina and State.
