Florida State's swimming team swept to its fifth dual meet victory Tuesday afternoon as the Seminoles downed South Carolina 66-47 at Union Pool.

Coach Bim Stults swimmers were in control of the meet from the start as they won eight of the 13 events.

Carolina, coached by former Seminole swimmer, Pete Combes, did not manage a win until the eighth event when Trond Williams edged Eric Morse in the 100-yard freestyle.

Florida State's divers continued their undefeated ways, capturing both the one and three meter events. USC's strong contingent, however, placed second and third both times.

Howie Acosta won the one-meter diving, edging Vic Laughlin and John Thoder of Carolina, while sophomore sensation Phil Boggs swept the three meter competition from the same two USC divers.

Other Florida State firsts went to Steve McNerney (1000

freestyle), Lee Eisinger (200-free), Dean Jerger (50 free), Ron Potts (Individual Medley), Bruce Rathman (Butterfly) and the Seminole Medley Relay team.

There were no double winners for either side, although Potts captured a second in the backstroke for the Seminoles in addition to his IM first. Carolina's Covic Stanwick took a first in the 500-yard freestyle and a second in the 1000.

The Seminoles' next meet will be Saturday against Florida, here. The Gators beat the Tribe earlier this season in a meet that went down to the final event in Gainesville.
