Florida State's swimmers have jumped into a commanding 55 point lead at the half-way point of the Independent Southern Championships being held at the University Union Pool.

Preliminaries for today's final events get underway at 9:30 a.m. After a break for lunch, the finals will start at 3 p.m. with the diving beginning an hour earlier.

The Tribe, with wins in six

of the nine finals held thus far, has rolled up an even 100 points, far outdistancing second place South Florida's 45.

The Brahmins, however, are in a nip and tuck battle for second with Tulane which has garnered 36. Not far back of those two is Miami with 28. Birmingham Southern trails the field with eight.

The Seminoles' Jim Thompson led a one-two-three sweep of the 500-yard freestyle Friday morning, and then came back to anchor the Tribe's victorious 800-yard freestyle relay team.

Miami's Bob Coleman had the day's biggest upset, as he edged FSU's premier sprinter, Dean Jerger in the 50-yard freestyle. Both swimmers were clocked in identical 22.4 seconds, but the judge's decision went to Coleman by less than a hands length.

Coleman also picked up points with a second place finish in the 200-yard breaststroke won by South Florida's Bill Kelly.

Florida State's elite diving corps swept the first three places in the one-meter competition. Phil Boggs was the winner, followed by Howie Acosta and Ken VonRoenn.

The 400-yard individual medley victory went to Joe Lewkowicz of South Florida as he topped FSU's Ron Potts.

Jim Harrison of the Seminoles came out on top in a blanket finish in the 200-yard freestyle. He was followed closely by Tulane's Same Milne and FSU's Ed Anderson.

The Tribe's Bruce Rathman and Dennis Shiels rounded out the day's individual winners capturing the 100-yard butterfly and backstroke events respectively.

With wins in 14 of the 18 events, Florida State's swimmers swept to an easy victory in the First Annual Independent Southern Swimming Championships at Union Pool this weekend.

The Seminoles totaled 202 points, outdistancing South Florida with 99, Tulane at 77, Miami 59 and Birmingham Southern 18.

Dennis Shiels was the meet's biggest point getter, as he picked up three first places in the 100 and 200-yard backstroke and the 200-yard individual medley.

His performance was closely followed by Seminole's Jim Thompson and Bruce Rathman who each had two individual wins plus a leg on a victorious relay.

Rathman turned in the most surprising performance of Saturday's events. The strong ~~junior~~ churned a sparkling 100-yard leg of the medley relay and then came right back to win the 200-yard butterfly event.

A native of Cincinnati, Rathman made up a five-yard deficit in the relay to spark a victory there. Then two events later he splashed to the win in the fly.

Thompson captured a win in the 500-yard freestyle Friday, and then showed his versatility by coming back to win the 100-yard free Saturday. He also swam a 200-yard leg of the Seminoles' victorious 800-yard freestyle relay.

John Stafford, co-captain of the Seminole squad this year with Shiels, swam a leg on each of the three relays for the Tribe.

Florida State's divers

dominated both the one and three meter competition, sweeping the first three places in each. Sophomore Phil Boggs won both events, with Ken Von Roenn and Howie Acosta sweeping second and third places.

South Florida's Bill Kelly was the meet's only other double winner, picking up firsts in the 100 and 200-yard breaststroke events.

One other first went to the Golden Bramahans when Joe Lewkowicz captured the 400-yard individual medley.

Miami's Bob Coleman was the only other non-Seminole to win. He grabbed the 50-yard freestyle on Friday.

Mark Jenkins won the gruelling 1,650-yard freestyle Saturday for the Seminoles. The other Tribe first went to Jim Harrison in the 200-yard free, Friday.
