CHAPEL HILL, N.C.—Florida State's swimming team overpowered North Carolina here Saturday 71-42 to wind up its four-day tour of the Carolinas.

The win gave the Seminoles a 3-1 mark for the trip and lifted their overall record to 5-2

in dual competition.

Coach Bim Stults' crew wasted no time jumping on the Tar Heels, capturing the 400- yard medley relay and the 1000-yard freestyle, the meet's first two events.

In the 200-yard freestyle, UNC picked up the first of its three wins on an afternoon that belonged to the Seminoles.

Dean Jerger, who along with the Tribe's Dennis Shiels were the only double winners,

captured the 50-yard freestyle with teammate Steve Connel

right behind.

Shiels captured the individual medley and a sweep of the one-meter diving by All-America Phil Boggs and Howie Acosta put the Seminoles well out in front to stay 34-18.

Jerger and Shiels combined again for back-to-back wins following the diving break, this time in the 100-yard freestyle and the backstroke as the Seminoles pulled even further ahead.

Florida State's freshman butterfly specialist, Marc Middleton, set a new school record with a 1:58.9 time in the 200-yard fly event.

After Carolina captured the 500 freestyle, the Seminoles swept both the breaststroke

and three-meter diving.

Norm Loges and Steve Driver placed one-two in the breaststroke, while Ken VonRoenn and Boggs had the

The Seminoles will be idle until next weekend when they travel to Tampa for a meet with South Florida on Saturday.
