TAMPA—Florida State's swimmers just took off and left the University of South Florida wading in the baby pool Saturday afternoon as the Seminole scored an easy 63-50 triumph.

Splashing to victories in four straight events before USF got untracked, the Tribe tankers pushed their record to 7-2. FSU won eight of 13 events.

Dean Jaeger and Mark Jenkins turned in sterling individual efforts winning two events each. Jaeger won the 50 and 100 yard freestyle competition and set a pool record in the former event of 21.9.

The long distance work of Jenkins earned the Seminole wins in the 200 and 500 yard freestyle competition.

Florida State grabbed the first place laurels in both relay events, but had to settle for a split in the diving events.

Ken VonRoenn captured the three meter diving event with a pool record 301.4 points. He placed third in the one meter competition.

"It wasn't too tough," said Coach Bim Stults. "We gave a

lot of younger swimmers a chance to get some experience."

Jerry Norris won the 100-yard freestyle for the Seminoles.

Florida State's next match will be with the University of Florida next Saturday in Gainesville.
