Florida State Coach Bim Stults played all his cards Wednesday and the Seminole swim team easily overcame the Aces of Evansville University 78-34 at Union Pool.

~~Stults, giving almost all his~~ swimmers an opportunity to get in the action, watched the Tribe capture 10 of 13 events, including one-two sweeps of six races in the season opener for FSU.

There were no double winners as hardly a Seminole was entered more than once.

The Tribe dominated things from the start, piling up a 42-10 margin before Evansville could capture its first victory in the meet's seventh event.

The medley relay team of Ed Anderson, Steve Driver, Chet Miltenberger and Jerry Stevens got the Seminoles off on the right foot, winning the 400-yard event in 3:57.16.

Mike Carter, the first of four Seminole freshmen to win, captured the 1,000-yard freestyle in 11:06.24. Lawton Harrison and Mike Seelie then turned in the first one-two in the 200-yard free event as the Seminoles jumped their lead to 20-5.

Stevens came back from his freestyle leg of the Medley Relay to win the 50-yard freestyle in 23.03 seconds.

A pair of freshman, Jeff Stone and Doug Shropshire swept the individual medley to ~~send the Seminoles into the~~ diving break with a 34-9 bulge.

All-America diver Phil Boggs was an easy winner in the one-meter competition rolling up

325.55 points. Freshman Tom Young of the Seminoles was second in the event.

Stefan Cooke got Evansville's first victory, in the butterfly. After Seminoles ~~Lee Eisinger and Al Drusys~~ swept the 100 freestyle, the Aces picked up their second win as Bruce Brink won the backstroke.

Seminole freshman Jody Hoch and Chuck Mitchell took a one-two in the 500-yard freestyle and Dennis Bunn and Jeff Selvey swept the breaststroke as the Tribe kept rolling up points.

Bill Lekas, Florida State's only entry in the three meter diving, won his event, before Evansville won the meet's final race, the freestyle relay, unchallenged by a Seminole entry.

Florida State's team will have several entries in the Swimming Hall of Fame Forum meets at Fort Lauderdale over the Holidays and will resume team competition Jan. 8, when the Seminoles journey to Atlanta for a three-way meet involving Georgia Tech and Emory and then to Athens to meet Georgia, Jan. 9.

The next home meet will be Jan. 15, when the Tribe hosts East Carolina.
