Florida State's swimming team warmed up for this afternoon's encounter Florida in Gainesville, with a hard-earned 59-54 win over defending Southern Conference champion East Carolina Friday afternoon.

Although the Seminoles jumped in front with a win in the meet's opening event, the 400-yard medley relay, the Pirates eventually took the lead and forced Coach Bim Stults' crew to come-frombehind.

"We didn't hold anyone back for Florida," said the veteran Tribe boss. "We couldn't afford to. Everyone of our swimmers were in the water."

Pirates actually captured seven of the 13 events, but could not match the Seminoles' depth and therein lies the tale of the meet.

After FSU's medley relay team put the Tribe in front, 7-0, ECU began to nibble away at the lead with wins in the 1000-yard freestyle and 200yard freestyle. The Pirates then surged ahead with a sweep of the 50-yard freestyle event.

ECU's Gary Frederick won the 1000, while Ed Anderson and Mike Carter were second and third for the Seminoles. The Pirates captured the 200 behind Jim Griffin and once again the Tribe pulled in second and third as their lead narrowed to 15-10.

In the 50, Paul Trevisan and Mark Wilson placed one-two for East Carolina as they went on top 18-16.

The Seminoles cut the lead

to one, 22-21 behind Mark never again behind. Middleton's triumph in the individual medley as one-meter diving came up.

All-America Phil Boggs and co-captain Terry Maxhimer put the Tribe back in front with a one-two sweep of the diving and the Seminoles were
