Florida State opened its 24th season of swimming in good fashion Saturday afternoon as the Seminoles swept past Evansville, 69-42, at Union Pool.

The Seminoles, who have not had a losing year since their first full season back in 1949, captured nine first places and set two meet records to insure the win.

Despite the lopsided score, Seminole Coach Bim Stults was anything but confident at the meet's outset. The Tribe was in a precarious position.

Stults had let his top freestyler, Jerry Stevens go home early — a move which, at the time, did not appear critical.

But suddenly Friday it looked as though Stevens points would be needed, when Larry Shoeman, the only FSU diver scheduled to compete, injured a shoulder and had to be scratched.

As it turned out, however, neither Shoeman nor Stevens were missed to any great extent.

Freshmen John Barnacastle and junior Mike Seelie took up the slack in the freestyle, winning the 50 and 100 yard events.

Another big winner was Chet Miltenberger who copped the day's only "double", winning the 200-yard freestyle and the 200-yard butterfly.

The Orlando native set a meet record in the butterfly

with a 2:05.7 clocking.

Only one other record fell during the afternoon meet. That one was snared by the Seminoles' John Hegert, who won the 200-yard backstroke in 2:05.24.

Two of Evansville's wins came in the uncontested diving events. Eddie Hooker captured the one-meter competition, while Randy Smith was victo-

rious in the three.

The Purple Aces other two wins came in the 100-yard freestyle, won by Steve Claus and the 200-yard Individual Medley won by Mike Rimroth.

Lawton Harrison took first place in the 500-yard freestyle, while Tom Arnold was a victor in the 200-yard breaststroke.

The Seminoles also captured both the medley and freestyle

relays.

Florida State's next dual meet will be Jan. 8 against

Georgia at Union Pool.
