

## FSU swim team cruises

Barry Griffin set a school record in the 1,000-freestyle while Steve Albritton and Craig Lindel emerged as double winners Saturday to lift the Florida State swim team to an easy 69-44 win over Georgia at the FSU Union Pool.

The Seminoles, now 6-1 and swimming its final home meet of the season, actually dominated the meet more than the score indicated, swimming to several wins in an "exhibition" status that didn't count in the scoring.
