

FSU men set four standards

AUSTIN, Texas — The Florida State men's swim team set four United States Indoor National Qualifying Standards Sunday.

FSU's Sam Seiple set the first standard, which quali-

fies one for the national meet in April, with a second place finish of 21.2 in the 50-meter freestyle.

The FSU relay team of Clark Morris, Dan Akre, Glenn Grant and Seiple set the second one, finishing third in a time of 2:28.89 in the 400 medley relay.

The FSU relay squad of Dan Neimer, Akre, Seiple and Grant set the third standard, a 6:52.54 third place finish in the 800 free relay. Brent Lindquist helped get the fourth standard when he teamed up with Grant, Akre and Seiple on the Seminole A squad and won the 400 free relay in a time of 3:05.50.
