

Georgia sweeps FSU

Georgia's Lisa Geiger, who won three individual events, and Todd Murphy, who captured the one-meter dive and placed second off the three-meter board, led Georgia to a sweep of the Florida State men and women in a college swimming meet on Friday at FSU.

The Lady Bulldogs won by an 88-52 margin as Geiger captured the 100-meter breaststroke, the 200 breaststroke and the 200 individual medley. It was the first meet of the year for the Georgia women, who won 11 of the 16 events.

The Georgia men won only six of the 13 events but edged the Seminoles 57-56. The Bulldogs are now 2-0 and FSU dropped to 1-2.

The Lady Seminoles were led by Sarah Linke, who won the 200 and 500 freestyle events. FSU diver Patsy O'Toole qualified for the NCAA zone meet in the both the one- and three-meter dives with scores of 250.5 and 269.7, respectively. Florida State's Wendy Fuller also qualified by winning the one-meter event with a 261.3 total.

Mike Kowalski was a winner in three events for the FSU men; taking the 50 freestyle and swimming a leg on both the 400 medley relay and the 400 freestyle relay. The Seminoles were without All-American Dan Akre, who is not eligible until January.
