FSU SWIMMER WINS NCAA 200 FLY TITLE, TEAM TAKES 9TH OVERALL

Minneapolis, MN -- The Florida State men's swimming and diving team made history tonight, as they not only took their first ever top ten finish at the NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships ever, they also saw sophomore Stephen Parry win the 200 yard butterfly title in a pool record time of 1:44.28. Parry, the ACC champion and record holder, became the first swimmer from Florida State to ever win a national championship as he took the lead on the first lap, and never let up. With a 9th place finish in the 100 fly last night, he helped lead FSU, which finished the regular season undefeated (10-0) and ranked 11th in the country, to a 9th place finish overall with 160 points. The 9th place is the highest finish ever for the Seminoles, beating their previous high of 18th in 1996.

"Going in there was a lot of pressure, being the #1 seed," said Parry, the first NCAA champion from the ACC since David Fox of North Carolina State in 1993. "But the coaches laid out the race for me, and it went from there."

#2 Auburn ran away with the meet to win their first NCAA swimming title ever. Auburn scored 495.5 to easily outdistance #1 Stanford (340), and third place #8 Georgia (297).

Sophomore Brendon Dedekind raced out to an early lead in the 100 yard freestyle, and held on for 4th with a time of 43.25, in what was the fastest 100 free final in history. Dedekind, coming into tonight already having placed 3rd in the 50 yard freestyle and 5th in the 100 yard breaststroke, finished the best all-around performance by a Florida State swimmer at the NCAA Championships ever, as by scoring in finals in all three of his individual events, he became the first in schol history to score in all three events, and the first to achieve three first team All-American finishes.

In the final event of the championships, the Seminoles 400 yard freestyle relay took 11th with a time of 2:57.42. Swimming on the relay were Dedekind, Parry, sophomore Matt McVittie, and senior Rob Braknis. By placing in the top sixteen, this marked the first time Florida State had all five relays score points at the NCAA Championships.

"We're happy with Steve's efforts, our first swimmer to win a national championships," said head coach Don Gibb.
"I'm also excited about the direction of the program. Three years ago, we were 39th in this meet. We've then improved to 25th, 18th, and now 9th"

FSU MEN'S SWIMMING TAKES THREE TOP EIGHT NCAA FINISHES, TEAM IN 9th AFTER 2ND DAY

Minneapolis, MN -- Unable to overcome the distance swimmers of Michigan and the divers of Miami, the Seminoles fell to 9th with 113 after the second day of competition at the 1997 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships. Held in Minneapolis, MN, on the University of Minnesota campus, FSU had four four All-American swims, but watched Michigan win the 800 yard freestyle relay and place three in the top eight of the 200 yard freestyle to move ahead of the Seminoles into 7th with 145. The University of Miami only scored in one event, but by placing four divers in the top 6 of the 3-meter event, they took 8th with 128 points. Florida State is still on pace to take their highest overall finish ever, as their previous high was 18th at last year's NCAA's.

Sophomore Brendon Dedekind, third in the 50 yard freestyle last night, was looking for another top three finish in the 100 breast, but couldn't hold on in the last 25 yards and came in 5th with a time of 54.27. Dedekind, the ACC Champion and record holder came into the meet ranked second in the country, but had to settle for his second first team All-American swim in as many days. Junior Jeremy Linn of Tennessee, the current American record holder, won in a time of 52.32.

Leading off the night was the 200 yard medley relay. The Seminole team, which came into the meet as the 1997 ACC Champions and record holders, finished 7th as senior Rob Braknis, freshman Brett Petersen, sophomore Stephen Parry, and Dedekind swam to a time of 1:19.51. In the morning preliminaries, they broke their own ACC record by swimming a 1:28.10.

In the 100 yard butterfly, Parry came into the meet ranked 5th in the nation, but in the morning preliminaries missed the championship heat by .01 seconds and ended up as the top seed in the consolation heat. Parry made the most of it by coming from behind in the last 25 yards to win the consolation heat and finish 9th in a time of 47.54. Parry also claimed second team All-American honors with his swim.

The Seminoles got a break in the 800 yard freestyle relay, as a disqualification of the Georgia team allowed the seminoles to take 16th with a time of 6:40.13. Swimming on the relay were junior Darren Milun, Parry, sophomore Matt McVittie, and senior team co-captain Chip Haberstroh.

Leading the competition and after their first NCAA championship title is #2 Auburn with 349 points, easily ahead of second place #1 Stanford (238.5 points)

FSU SWIMMER MISSES NCAA 50 FREESTYLE TITLE BY .06 SECONDS, TEAM TIED FOR 7th AFTER 1ST DAY

Minneapolis, MN -- Led by sophomore All-American and South African Olympian Brendon Dedekind, the 11th ranked Florida State men's swimming and diving team used three All-American swims to tie for 7th place with the 19th ranked University of Miami with 64 points after the first day of competition at the 1997 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships, held in Minneapolis, MN. The Seminoles are already ahead of last year's total point total, as they scored 58 at the 1996 NCAA's, where they finished 18th, which was also the highest in school history.

Dedekind, who was the top seed and ACC Champion coming into the meet, took the early lead in the 50 freestyle, but couldn't hold off Brett Hawke of Auburn and Neil Walker of Texas, and was touched out in the last five yards to finish third with a time of 19.26, which ties his school record. The third place for Dedekind was the highest individual finish ever by a Florida State swimmer at the NCAA Championships. Walker had set the NCAA record in the morning preliminaries with a 19.08, but couldn't keep the pace at night as he came in at 19.25, while Hawke took the title with a time of 19.16. Dedekind was ninth in the 50 freestyle at the meet last year as a freshmam. The morning preliminaries was the fastest in NCAA history, as the top sixteen qualifiers for the scoring session at night all went under 20 seconds.

Leading off the night was the 200 Freestyle relay. The Seminole team, which came into the meet as the 1997 ACC Champions and record holders, finished 7th as Dedekind, senior Eduardo Coelho, sophomore Matt McVittie, and senior Rob Braknis swam to a time of 1:19.51. The 200 free relay team also had their highest finish ever at the NCAA Championships, as well as the first 200 free relay in FSU history to achieve 1st team All-American status.

The Seminole's other relay of the night also captured 1st team All-American honors, as it took 7th with a time of 3:15.92. Braknis led off the relay on the backstroke leg, Dedekind swam the breaststroke, sophomore Stephen Parry swam the butterfly, while Coelho swam the anchor freestyle. It was the highest finish for the 400 medley relay in school history, as well as the first time the 400 medley relay took 1st team All-American.

Leading the competition and after their first NCAA championship title is #2 Auburn, with 173 points.

Ryk Neethling, Arizona, 1650 yard freestyle (14:43.44) "That was one of the reasons I came to the U.S., because of the training. That's why I went to Arizona because Chad (Carvin) was there. He got sick, but he's back in the pool now. He has helped me a lot in my swimming."

"I really wasn't satisfied with my race. The guy next to me from Kansas went out really fast, and I just tried to stay with him. I kind of died at the end. I've been traveling a lot. I went home and to the Pac-10s."

Lars Frolander, Southern Methodist, 100 yard freestyle (42.89), his second NCAA title of the meet (He won the 100 yard butterfly last night) "I felt more comfortable with the 100 free (than the 100 fly). I pretty much knew what I could do in this race. I thought I was going to go out a little faster than I did this morning."

"In the 100 fly, you really don't know what kind of shape you are going to be in. I'm usually pretty stable in the 100 free the whole meet."

Lenny Krayzelburg, USC, 200 yard freestyle (1:41.10 *pool record) "I felt pretty good tonight, it's been a long week."

"I was pretty happy with the swim, I'm not used to swimming this many races. I was shooting for the pool record in the race and I got it."

Jeremy Linn, Tennessee, 200 yard breaststroke (1:55.27 *pool record) "I was a little nervous tonite after my morning race. I tried to take it out a little smoother tonite and relaxed a bit."

"I was 3rd my freshman, 2nd last year, and have been looking forward to winning this race for the past two years. This win is big for me."

Stephen Parry, Florida State, 200 yard butterfly (1:44.28 *pool record), won the first NCAA swimming title in Florida State history "It's all kind of a blur. I haven't really thought about it yet. Going in as a No. 1 seed, there was some pressure. I am just pleased to get it out of the way. My coach planned out my whole race and I just followed his plan."

"Obviously having an Olympic silver medalist (Tom Malchow) in the race is daunting. It was anyone's race tonight. The wealth of talent here is quite amazing."

"That was one of my motivating factors. Every moment at Florida State has been precious. I am pleased that I could give something back to that university."
