FSU ANNOUNCES HIRING OF SWIMMING AND DIVING COACH (Neil Harper returns to FSU after two years at Ohio State)

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- Florida State University Director of Athletics Dave Hart announced Friday the hiring of Neil Harper, former head women's swimming coach at Ohio State University, as the new head coach for the men's and women's swimming and diving teams.

"We are pleased to have Neil join our staff," Kim Record, Associate Athletic Director and Senior Women's Administrator said. "He is familiar with the tradition of our program and shares the same vision as the administration for its future."

"I'm excited with the potential the Florida State swimming program already has established," Harper said. "I'm impressed with the development of the athletic facilities and with the university overall in the two years I have been gone."

Harper becomes Florida State's third women's coach and seventh men's coach after two years as the head coach for the women's swimming team at Ohio State University. In his two year tenure, the women's team finished in ninth place in the Big Ten Conference both years and was 15-12 overall. Harper is a member of the American Swim Coaches Association (ASCA) and the College Swim Coaches Association of America (CSCAA).

Before taking the helm at Ohio State, Harper served as an assistant coach at Florida State under Don Gibb for three years where he was responsible for recruiting and developing the strength and conditioning programs for both teams. He helped coach 17 swimmers to NCAA All-American status, one national champion and a top 10 finish for the men and top 30 finish for the women in the NCAA.

"I knew the potential at Florida State and I can't wait to step foot back on campus," Harper said. "I'm happy to be back in Tallahassee and have the opportunity to complete something I started three years ago with the 1996 recruiting class."

Upon graduation from Louisiana State, Harper served as an assistant coach for the Tigers from 1988-94, coaching 21 All-Americans and seven SEC titles. During his six years, both the men's and women's teams finished in the top 15 in the NCAA. As a student-athlete at LSU, he was a seven time All-American, four-time SEC Champion and was team captain in 1988. He also competed in the 1984 and 1988 Olympic Games on the British National Team where he was a member of the 400 meter Medley Relay team that finished 6th at the 1984 games and 4th in the 1988 games.

Harper and his wife Paige, also an NCAA All-American and SEC breaststroke champion, have been married for eight years and have two daughters, Katherine (4) and Kelly (2).

FLORIDA STATE DIVING WELCOMES NEW COACH (Olympian Patrick Jeffrey to head up the diving squad)

TALLAHASSEE, FL - Florida State head swimming and diving coach Neil Harper announced that Patrick Jeffrey, a former diver at Ohio State University, has joined the Florida State coaching staff as the head diving coach.

"I am extremely excited that Patrick has accepted the opportunity to be our new head diving coach," Harper said. "He is regarded as one of the best diving coaches in the country and has coached several national champions. The athletic department and myself are excited about the future of our diving program under Patrick's guidance."

Jeffrey comes to FSU from Boca Raton, Fla., where he has produced four Individual Senior National Champions, three Individual Junior National Champions and four Individual World Cup Team members. He served as the USA Senior World Cup Team Coach in 1997 and 1999, the Senior National Team Coach from 1997-99 and the Junior National Team Coach in 1998.

As a diver, Jeffrey competed in the 1988 Olympics in Seoul and 1996 Olympics in Atlanta where he was a finalist on the 10m Platform at both games. He is also a three-time US Diving National Champions on the 10m Platform.

A graduate of Ohio State University, Jeffrey was a three-time NCAA Champion in 1988, winning the 1m, 3m and 10m platform. he also received the NCAA Diver of the Year award in the same year. He received his bachelors degree in journalism and advertising in 1988.

FLORIDA STATE SWIMMING AND DIVING COMPLETES SECOND DAY AT NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

MINNEAPOLIS, MN -- Seniors Brent Burkman and Brett Petersen completed their second day of competition at the 2000 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships in Minneapolis, Minn. Burkman competed in the 3-meter diving with Petersen swimming the 100 Breast.

After finishing 25th in the 1-meter diving on Thursday, Burkman moved up five spots to clinch 20th in the 3-meter diving with a score of 487.70. Petersen, who finished 2nd in the 100 Breast at the ACC Championships, was disqualified in the preliminaries of the event and did not swim in the evening session.

The Seminoles will conclude competition tomorrow in Minneapolis. Burkman will dive in the 10m platform competition while Petersen swims in the 200 Breast.

FLORIDA STATE SWIMMER AND DIVER COMPETE IN NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

(Brent Burkman and Brett Petersen will compete in Minneapolis)

TALLAHASSEE, FL – Two Florida State Seminoles will compete at the NCAA Men's swimming and diving championships in Minneapolis, Minn., this weekend. Senior Brent Burkman will compete in the diving events with fellow senior Brett Petersen competing in the Breaststroke events.

Burkman makes his first career appearance at the NCAA Championships after finishing 10th on the 1-meter, 13th on the 10-meter platform and 17th on the 3-meter at the NCAA Zone B Diving meet, hosted by Auburn University. A four year letter winner from Ruston, Va., Burkman won the 1-meter competition and finished 4th on the 3-meter at the 2000 ACC Championships. He has made the finals on both the 1-meter and 3-meter all four years as Seminoles, including taking 3rd on both boards at the 1998 and 1999 Championships. In 1997, Burkman finished 7th on both boards. He is a two-time All-ACC Honor Roll selection and has been named Florida State's men's diver of the year for two consecutive years. Burkman is the first diver to qualify for the meet since 1992 and will compete in the 1-meter and 3-meter as well as the 10-meter platform.

Petersen is a returning All-American from the 1999 championships. A native of Pietermaritzburg, South Africa, Petersen finished 2nd in the 200 Breast and 9th in the 100 Breast at the 2000 ACC Championships. He was also a member of the 2nd place 400 Medley Relay and 3rd place 200 Medley Relay at the conference meet. At the 1999 Championships, Petersen competed in the 100 and 200 Breast and the 400 Medley Relay. He took 2nd in the 200 Breast in the 1998 and 1999 conference championships and was on the 1997, 1998 and 100 ACC Champion 200 Medley Relay team. Petersen also competes internationally, including a 4th place finish in the 100m Breast at the Pan-Pacific Championships in Sydney, Australia last summer.

Burkman will compete in the 1-meter on Thursday, March 23 with the 3-meter on Friday, March 24 and the platform on Saturday, March 25. Petersen will compete in the 100 Breast on Friday and 200 Breast on Saturday. The preliminaries begin at Noon with the finals at 7:00pm each day.

FLORIDA STATE MEN'S SWIMMING AND DIVING THIRD AFTER DAY ONE OF ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS

(Senior Brent Burkman wins one-meter diving)

CHAPEL HILL, NC – The Florida State men's swimming and diving team is in third place after the first day of competition at the ACC Championships in Chapel Hill, NC. Virginia leads the meet with 242 points, followed by North Carolina with 201.5 points and FSU with 162 points.

The 200 Free Relay team of Greg Main-Baillie, Joey Marshburn, Nnamnse Ammons and Kevin Flanagan started the meet, winning the event in an NCAA Consideration time of 1:20.62. Main-Baillie followed with a 12th place finish in the 200 IM (1:50.16) with an NCAA Consideration time as Justin Betts finished 15th in the event (1:53.11). Flanagan then took 5th in the 50 Free (20.41) with Ammons taking 7th (20.60), Marshburn 13th (20.87) and Will McReynolds 16th (21.11). Main-Baillie and Flanagan were joined by Brett Petersen and Devon Crock in a 2nd place finish in the 400 Medley Relay in an NCAA Consideration time of 3:15.11.

Senior diver Brent Burkman unseated the reigning champion Andy Johnson from NC State by only 5.1 points to win the one-meter springboard tonight with 514 points. Glen Gonzales took the 4th spot with 479.90 points as Lou Dondero finished 8th with 401.75 points.

BATON ROUGE, LA -- The Florida State men's and women's swimming and diving teams fell to the LSU Tigers this morning in Baton Rouge. The #22 Seminoles fell to #19 LSU 147-96 as the Lady Tigers topped the Lady Seminoles 139-104.

Greg Main-Baillie won the first event for the Seminoles with a win in the 200 IM (1:51.87) followed by a second place finish in the 200 Back (1:52.49). Nelson Mora also had a win in the 200 Fly (1:51.64) and finished second in the 200 Free (1:41.06).Danny Chocron added points with second place finishes in the 1000 Free (9:30.50) and the 500 Free (4:40.31) with Bill Schultz following in third in both events (9:37.79 and 4:42.12 respectively). Kevin Flanagan took second in the 50 Free (20.65) and 100 Free (46.02) with Brett Petersen finishing third in the 200 Breast (2:04.62). Also with top finishes were Joey Marshburn, third in the 50 Free (21.04); Steve Forson, third in the 200 Fly (1:53.36); Jonathan Kaplan, third in the 200 Back (1:56.20); and Justin Bettts in the 200 Breast (2:08.06). In diving action, Brent Burkman took the third spot in the one-meter (285.078) and fourth in the three-meter (271.425) as Glenn Gonzales finished third in the three-meter (285.075) and fourth in the one-meter (271.425). The Seminoles ended the meet with Jay McGarity, Nnamnse Ammons, Julian Daily and Will McReynolds finishing second in the 400 Free Relay (3:07.13).

The Lady Seminoles led the meet after the first four events and established two NCAA Consideration times. Amber Goodwin, Keryn Krynauw, Summer Bell and Christy Cech won the opening event, 400 Medley Relay, in a time of 3:49.99. Cech then took the 50 Free in an NCAA Consideration time of 23.38 and finished second in the 100 Free (51.18). Tanya Gurr finished second in the 200 Free in her NCAA Consideration time of 1:50.14 and took third in the 100 Free (51.55). Kristen Adams added a win for the Lady Seminoles in the 500 Free (5:00.95) and finished second in the 1000 Free (10:23.81). Anne Blachford added a win in the 200 IM (2:05.33) with Bell finishing second (2:08.17). Other top finishes included Krynauw with a second place finish in the 200 Breast (2:18.81), Goodwin with a second place finish in the 200 Back (2:04.11), and Kathleen McCubbins with a third place finish in the 200 Fly (2:07.02). Marya Sabesky led the divers, finishing fourth on the one-meter (233.550) and three-meter (241.35) with Caren Hirai finishing fifth (230.70 and 230.025 respectively).Gurr, Blachford, Adams and Christine Williams finished the meet with a win in the 400 Free Relay (3:28.55).

The Seminoles end the season with a 7-4 record (1-1 in the ACC) as the Lady Seminoles finish 9-4 (1-0 in the ACC). Both team begin preparation for the ACC Championships, which will be held in Chapel Hill, N.C., hosted by the University of North Carolina. FLORIDA STATE SWIMMING DROPS TO AUBURN (FSU returns to action on November 12th as they host Indian River Community College)

TALLAHASSEE, FL -- The Florida State swimming and diving teams fell to the Auburn Tigers this afternoon at the Bim Stults Aquatic Center in Tallahassee. The men lost to the defending national champions and second-ranked Tigers 132-108 as the women fell to the eighth-ranked Lady Tigers 140-102.

The Seminoles started the meet with Greg Main-Baillie, Brett Petersen, Steve Forson and Kevin Flanagan edging out the Tigers in the 400 Medley Relay to win the event in a time of 3:22.32. TALAHASSEE, FL -- The Florida State swimming and diving teams went 2-1 today in Atlanta as they took on the NC State Wolfpack and Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets at the Georgia Tech Aquatic Center. The Lady Seminoles defeated NC State 163-123 as the Seminoles topped Georgia Tech 210-88 but dropped one to NC State 152-148.

FSU divers Marya Sabesky, Caren Hirai and Anne Oglesby took 3rd, 4th and 5th respectively in the 1-meter and 3-meter diving. Senior Tanya Gurr took first in the 200 Free with sophomore Amber Goodwin winning the 200 Back. Junior Kristen Adams also won the 500 Free followed by Lisa Kirsch.

The Seminoles came out strong, taking the top three spots in every event except for the 200 Free, 200 Breast, and 400 Free Relay. Senior Danny Chocron won the 500 and 1000 Free as senior Nelson Mora took the 200 Fly and 200 Free. Junior Greg Main-Baillie added points with his win in the 200 IM and 200 Back and senior All-American Kevin Flanagan won the 50 and 100 Free. Seminole divers Glenn Gonzales, Lou Dondero and Ben Nuttall took the 3rd, 4th and 5th spot in the 1-meter and 3-meter respectively.

The two teams return to action next weekend as they travel to Atlanta, Ga. The women will take on the NC State Wolfpack as the men take on the Wolfpack and the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets. The meet begins at Noon at the Georgia Tech Aquatic Center.
