

The Florida State University tennis team again failed to win a set as the Seminoles were shut-out here Friday afternoon by Davidson College 9 to 0. The Indians have now dropped 38 straight sets to opponents Pensacola Naval Air Station and Davidson.

Still playing without the services of two of their top aces, Herb Quay who is ill and Bob Lanigan who was delayed in returning to school this quarter, Florida State was no match for the strong Davidson squad.

Paced by Bo Roddy, the South's fourth ranking tennis player, and four left-handed teammates, Davidson trimmed the Seminoles with loss of only 30 games in the 18 sets played.
