

FSU Netters Seek Second Win Today, Top Georgia, 6-3

Off to a winning start with a 6-3 triumph over Georgia yesterday, Florida State University's tennis team was scheduled to go, after its second win today against the Jacksonville (Ala.) State Teachers.

The meet today was slated at the varsity courts, site of yesterday's victory over Georgia.

The Seminoles, coached by Dr. Don Loucks, grabbed four of the singles and two of the doubles in defeating the Bulldogs.

The feature match of the day saw FSU's number one man, Hal Schaus, come from a 2-5 deficit in the third set to defeat Georgia ace Merritt Pound, 7-5, 4-6, 8-6.
