

Florida State's sophomore-dominated tennis team goes after its second win of the young 1957 season here this afternoon against Georgia Tech, after defeating Mercer 8-1 here yesterday.

The Seminole netters, with three sophs winning singles matches, lost only one doubles match as they swamped the visiting Bears for their first 1957 victory.

In that doubles match, Buddy Moore and Bill Causey of the visitors defeated senior Sonny Sellers and soph Jim Maddock of the Seminoles, 6-3, 6-2.

Sophomores Lex Hester, Frank Bryan and Jackie Crew, juniors Dave Tiedt and Russ Rollinger and Sellers all won their singles matches, with only Hester and Bryan being pressed to three sets.
