

Northwestern's powerful tennis team whipped Florida State 7-2 at the FSU courts Monday, winning every doubles match and four of six singles matches. The two teams will vie again today at 2:30.

Northwestern's All-American Marty Reissen, twice national singles runner-up (to Southern Cal's Raphael Osuna as a sophomore and last year to USC's Dennis Ralston) overpowered Florida State star Lex Wood in two final sets to win their return match.

Wood, who whipped Reissen here last year, used powerful service to sweep their first set, 6-3. But Reissen, twice Big Ten singles champ and member of the 1963 U. S. Davis Cup team, turned to beautiful-net play.

Wood tried to drive Reissen back with high lob shots, but

the 6-3 Northwestern star put them away with powerful smashes out of the South African's reach.

It was only the second regular-season loss for Wood, who has been nominated for a position on the South Africa Davis Cup team. Wood had missed the Seminoles' three previous matches, last Thursday and Saturday, with an attack of flu.

Reissen and teammate Clark

Graebner, second-ranked men's doubles team in America, teamed to thrash Wood and Don Caton in doubles action.

Graebner, who lost to Caton here in singles last year, won first and third sets from the Pensacola Senior to win their singles match Tuesday.

Paul Bennett, junior from Charleston, W. Va. and Don Monk of Mansfield, O., won singles matches for Florida State.
