

CLEMSON, S. C. — A pressure filled doubles victory by Lex Wood and Steve Guse gave Florida State a 5-4 tennis victory over Clemson yesterday.

Playing in the last match of the day, the two Seminoles won 8-10, 10-8, 10-8 over Doug Stewart and Mallory Evans to give Coach Paul Scarpa's team its tenth victory against eight defeats.

Wood, Don Caton and Paul Bennett — the top three FSU players — won their singles matches, but the bottom half of the order lost, leaving the score tied going into doubles play. Don Monk and Steve Burt dropped their match, but Caton and Bennett won, setting the stage for the decisive marathon.

The Seminoles play at Presbyterian today.
