

Florida State's tennis team defeated Rutgers 9-0 again Tuesday at the FSU courts. The victory gave the Seminoles, who meet Valdosta State here today at 2:30 p.m., a 10-2 record.

Rutgers, losers to FSU by the same score Monday, switched its lineup Tuesday and threw No. 1 Vic Figlar against State's Paul Bennett. The 5-10 junior dropped the opening set, then won, 6-3, 6-3. Rutgers' Richard Robinson, meanwhile, pushed Florida State's No. 1 player, Paul de Zeeuw, to 18 games in the second set before losing.
