

**GAINESVILLE** — Florida State's tennis team got solid support from its No. 2, 3, 4 players Wednesday and handed the University of Florida a 5-4 net setback.

Coach Lex Wood's courtmen managed three singles victories and two doubles and Paul Bennett, Stu Bruner and Terry Poore figured in all these.

Bennett, No. 2, defeated Steve Gardner 3-6, 6-1 while No. 3 man Bruner escaped Bill Perrin 6-2, 6-4. No. 4 Poore downed Bill Belote 6-1, 6-2.

Bruner and Poore combined for one doubles victory while Bennett teamed with Rick Cameron for the other Seminole decision.

Florida State's next home action is Monday against the University of Miami before the dual-match finale Tuesday against defending Big Ten champion Indiana.
