The Vols bowed to Florida State yesterday, but not without quite a battle. Lenny Schloss, after gaining a 6-0 first set triumph, fell to Paul DeZeeuw, 6-4, 11-9, in the next two. Richard Dow also dropped an 11-9 set as he bowed to FSU's Clint Murphy, 6-1, 11-9.
