

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. — The University of Tennessee's tennis team defeated Florida State 7-0 Friday to avenge its only loss of the season.

The Vols' no. 1 and no. 2 players, both nationally ranked, also redeemed themselves. Lenny Scholoss, the top netter, beat FSU's Paul Dezeuw 5-7, 6-0, 6-3, while no. 2 Jack Jackson downed Steve Guse 6-1, 6-0.

In other singles matches, FSU's Stew Bruner lost to Kenny Marcus, 6-2, 6-8, 6-3; Clint Murphy lost to Bob Dow 6-1, 6-3; Russ Langstroth lost to Richard Dow 6-1, 4-6, 8-6, and Terry Poore lost to Rick Christian 7-5, 7-5.

Two doubles matches were called because of darkness. Guse and Terry Poore were leading Jackson and Scholoss 6-4, 7-5 when the match was called. The other doubles action hadn't started.
