Rollins' tennis team made it victory number 22 for the season Wednesday with a 5-4 defeat of Florida State.

The Tars were extended to three sets in five of the matches, winning only two of these five. The matches required almost five hours to complete.

JIM GRIFFITH, freshman from Ocala, won his singles match to extend his unbeaten set mark to 22. Teammate Bob McCannon also won to stay undefeated for the year.

The win marked the third
