

Florida State's No. 2 and 3 doubles team battled from behind to lead a 5-4 tennis upset over defending NCAA small college champion Rollins here Friday afternoon.

The victory was the fourth of the season for FSU against three defeats. The loss was the first of the year for Rollins, now 6-1. The losers racked up a 32-1 record last season and had the same personnel coming back.

The singles were split with each team taking three matches. The surprise of the day was Stu Bruner's victory over Rollins ace Cliff

Montgomery, 6-4, 6-2. It was Montgomery's first loss in two years of varsity tennis.
