

WINTER PARK — Florida State's tennis team ran its record to 11-5 Monday with a 5-3 victory over Rollins College, the defending NCAA college division national champion.

The Seminoles took four of six singles matches, but Clint Murphy, who had won 14 of 16 matches this year including nine in a row, was beaten by Jim Griffith 15-13, 6-4.

—Paul de Zeeuw of FSU lost to Ron Van Geoder 3-6, 6-2, 6-3. Stu Bruher, FSU, defeated Bob McConnom 4-6, 6-0, 9-7; Bob Marcher, FSU, beat Chick Hawly 6-4, 4-6, 6-4; Dave Danielson, FSU, defeated Cliff Montgomery 6-2, 6-1, and Herb Rapp, FSU, beat Bill Kinne 7-5, 6-1.

In the only doubles match, de Zeeuw and Danielson defeated Van Geoder and Montgomery 7-5, 8-6. The other two doubles matches were called because of darkness.
