

Florida State's tennis team captured its third consecutive victory by overrunning the University of Virginia 8-1 Wednesday morning on the home courts.

The triumph marked the end of a brief three-match home stand which elevated the Tribe's season record to 4-2.

Other than No. 3 man Al Procopio, none of the Seminole singles players was threatened seriously in his individual match. Procopio executed several cross-court service returns in the final set to cap a 4-6, 6-3, 6-3 comeback victory.

Herb Rapp, FSU's rangy No. 2 singles player who maintains a relentless net rush, scored his third straight win by the score of 6-2, 6-2. Rapp had previously earned twin victories over Kalamazoo College by that margin.

The FSU netters traveled to Starkville, Mississippi, on Wednesday to begin a series of matches today with Michigan State, Mississippi State, and Oklahoma.
