Oklahoma University, champion of the Big Eight Conference, became Florida State's sixth victim of the young tennis season when Lex Wood's netters upended the Sooners 5-2 at Starkville, Mississippi Saturday morning.

The Seminoles' 7-2 victory over Michigan State on Friday, coupled with Oklahoma's 5-2 defeat of MSU on Thurşday, pointed toward a tight match between the Tribe and Sooners. However, FSU reeled off four victories in the five singles contests to insure a team victory before doubles play began. The rampaging racquetmen thus scored their fifth team victory in six recent outings to establish the season mark at 6-2.

Herb Rapp and Scott Bristol elevated their personal singles records to 7-1. Both scored victories over the Oklahoma opponents by identical 6-2, 6-2 counts.

The feature match involved Jerry Perry, the top Sooner netman, and No. 1 Seminole Dave Danielson. Perry's tireless, maneuvering and versatile ground strokes belied his small, unimposing appearance and nearly outgunned Danielson. Site a d i n e s s of backhand, an effective looping forehand, and crackling overhead smashes saved matters for the Tribe ace, 7-5, 3-6, 8-6. John DeZeeuw evoked memories of his brother Paul Seminole ace from 1965 through 1967, by dominating the net attack to defeat Glen Mullins, 6-2, 3-6, 6-3. Both DeZeeuw and Danielson have 6-2 personal singles marks which match the team record.

DeZeeuw and Roberto Marcher took the measure of Mullins and Bruce Barrett, 1-6, 6-3, 6-3 to maintain an undefeated doubles record for the 1968 season.
