

FSU Netters Take Fourth 9-0 Triumph

Florida State netters registered their fourth consecutive 9-0 victory Saturday afternoon by downing Northern Illinois on the home courts.

The victory was FSU's sixth straight, marked the tenth win of the season.

FSU encountered some resistance from Northern Illinois in the doubles matches, only after six singles points had insured the team victory. Dave Danielson's and Al Procopio's took a 7-5, 7-5 doubles win, overcoming a 2-5 deficit in the second set.

John DeZeeuw and Roberto Marcher had some difficulty in posting their ninth straight doubles victory. Trailing 1-3 during the third set, DeZeeuw and Marcher volleyed with greater authority at net and won five of six games to take the match.

Danielson's 10 wins in 12 singles matches have nailed down the No. 1 position, while he and Procopio show a 9-3 record in doubles play.

Herb Rapp, the No. 2 racketman, and No. 6 man Scott Bristol lead the Seminoles with identical 11-1 singles marks.

The Seminoles begin a full week of action Monday afternoon at Winter Park, where they meet Rollins, the NCAA college division champions for 1966-67.
