

FSU Netters Win Ninth

Spurred by five of six singles victories, the streaking FSU tennis team captured its ninth consecutive win by downing Oglethorpe 7-2 here Wednesday afternoon.

The Tribe also scored two of the three doubles points to elevate the season record to 13-2.

Dave Danielson, the top FSU netter, dropped his third individual match of the year, a 6-1, 7-5 loss to Robbie Smith, while Herb Rapp, No. 2 Seminole netter, earned his 13th straight triumph of the season by outbelting Joe Dennis 8-6, 4-6, 6-4.

John DeZeeuw and Bob Marcher collided with Smith and Dennis in the feature doubles match and maintained their undefeated record by posting an 8-6, 6-3 win.

FSU meets Auburn here at 1 p.m. Saturday, then travels to Miami for a Monday afternoon contest.
