

Florida State's tennis team shut out Calvin College 9-0 while the University of Virginia edged Kalamazoo College 5-4 Thursday in the Spring Festival round robin at the Tully gym courts.

It was the fifth straight victory for the Seminoles, now 8-3-1 on the season.

Virginia found rough going against Kalamazoo as the teams split in singles competition 3-3. Virginia captured two of the three doubles matches for the win.

This morning Florida State was to meet Kalamazoo while this afternoon the Seminoles are scheduled to face Virginia at 2. The tourney ends Saturday.
