**GAINESVILLE** — Florida State's tennis team had a 12-game victory streak snapped here Wednesday as the Seminoles bowed to the University of Florida 8-1.

The Seminoles managed only one singles win when Randy Jobson defeated Paul Lunetta 6-2, 7-5. But FSU made it rough for the Gator netters sending four other matches in three games each.

Florida State, now 14-1, entertains Columbus (Ga.) State Friday and plays host to the University of Miami Saturday afternoon.
