

FSU Netters Post 3rd Win

Florida State's superior depth was the deciding factor yesterday as the Seminoles dropped both the first two singles matches and the number one doubles, but rallied to take a 6-3 win over talented Presbyterian College on FSU courts.

The visitors from South Carolina proved to be very strong at the top, but could not match the Tribe's strength in the lower positions.

Milan Kofol and Ralph Hart were winners in the two feature singles matches. Kofol defeated FSU's Ricardo Bernd 7-6, 6-1 while Hart had to go to three sets, 6-4, 4-6, 7-5, to topple Juan Ortiz. It was the first setback of the season for the two Seminoles.

The Seminoles next match will be March 20 against Tennessee Tech. The Tribe is 3-0 for the year.
