

Seminole Netters Post 11th Victory

For the first time this season, Florida State's unbeaten tennis team swept the first three singles matches then relied on its usual strong performance from the doubles to clip Wake Forest 6-3 yesterday at Tully Court.

It was the 11th straight victory for the Seminoles who were to host Virginia this afternoon after dealing Wake Forest its first loss in 13 matches.

Ricardo Bernd, Juan Ortiz and Reggie Genois staked the Seminoles to their first 3-0 lead of the season, but still it was the doubles that pulled out the victory.

Wake Forest, in the process of deadlocking the matches at 3-3 going into the doubles, was also the first team this season to clip the Seminoles' second three singles players in one whack.

The Seminoles clinched the victory on a 6-3, 4-6, 6-4 match to Bernd and Steve Diamond. It came after the team of Ortiz-Bob Boland defeated Gary Copper-Jim Haslam 6-2, 6-2 and before Richard Legendre-Genois defeated Audley Bell-Dean Mathios 6-3, 4-6, 14-12.
