

## FSU Posts 7-2 Tennis Victory

Florida State's tennis team wasted little time in beating Kentucky 7-2 yesterday at Tully Court. The Seminoles took the first five singles spots and the first two doubles.

The most impressive singles win was turned in by Reggie Genoio, who allowed only three points to Steve Gilliam, winning the two sets 6-0 and 6-2.

It was the first win in three outings for the Tribe netters who came off back - to - back losses to Miami and North Carolina.

The Tribe's record now stands at 3-2 for the season while Kentucky dropped to 1-1.

The Seminoles next match will be Friday against Kalamazoo College at the Tully Courts.
